Information

Hellekis Säteri is a manor estate with a long history located at the foot of Kinnekulle. On the estate, there are other attractions such as an art gallery, a retro shop, a perennial and rose garden, as well as a restaurant and garden café.

In the indoor venue (the greenhouse), there is also a café area.

The manor is one of Kinnekulle's most visited tourist destinations and hosts a number of events annually, including a large Christmas market every autumn.

There are plenty of parking spaces available for both visitors and exhibitors adjacent to the exhibition area.

Welcome to Sweden's only Mineral show in a mansion environment.

Location of show tables

The show includes an indoor exhibition housed in the large greenhouse as well as a larger number of tables along the long side and at the back of the greenhouse. The outdoor and indoor exhibitions will thus be "connected."

Outdoor tables are sized 3 x 0.8 m and are equipped with a roof frame. Tarpaulin or roof plastic and clamps must be brought by the exhibitors themselves. A limited number of tarpaulins and clamps are available for rental from SGS and can be found at the show information desk.

The number of outdoor tables is limited to a maximum of 4 tables per exhibitor.

The indoor tables are available in two different sizes. The larger tables are the same size as the outdoor tables, namely 3 x 0.8 m. The number of large indoor tables is limited to a maximum of 3 tables per exhibitor.

The smaller indoor tables are so-called conference tables which are approximately 180 x 80 cm. The number of small indoor tables is limited to a maximum of 2 tables per exhibitor.

There is also access to electricity for the indoor tables.

The venue for the indoor exhibition will of course be locked at night. The venue will be locked at 18:00 on Saturday evening and will be unlocked at 08:00 on Sunday morning.

The venue for the indoor exhibition will be open:

Friday: at 4pm – 10pm

Saturday: at 7am – 6pm

Sunday: from 8am

Please note, as the total number of indoor and outdoor tables is limited, reservations are on a "first come, first served" basis.

Insurance/Taxes

Exhibitors are responsible for insuring their exhibited goods and any applicable taxes.

Some Practical Information

Registration upon arrival and information about table placement will be done at the SGS information desk.

Toilets are available in the form of portable restrooms near the exhibition area.

General Regulations

Only minerals, rocks, fossils, literature, or items made of stone, as well as equipment for processing, examining, or storing stones and minerals, may be exhibited/sold.

All goods must be clearly price-marked, either individually with a price tag or in groups with a sign (e.g., Hematite necklace 120:-/each). All prices must be specified in SEK (Swedish kronor).

Artificial materials, such as synthetic stones or dyed minerals, must be clearly labeled with information about this. This also applies to artificial fossils.

Exhibitors commit to display throughout the entire fair/both days (unless otherwise agreed with the organizer) and absolutely not put down their goods before the show closes.

All sales must take place from tables rented by the organizer. Personal tables for exhibition and sales are generally not allowed, but may be permitted in special cases if the organizer gives consent. Auxiliary tables must be placed separate from the sales tables. SGS fair manager reserves the right to interpret this matter.

NOTE: All sales must be made from tables rented by the organizer. No own sales tables or expansion of the sales area with discs etc. are allowed. Only so-called Packing or unloading tables are permitted provided that these are kept separate from the sales tables.

Hazardous substances such as radioactive or toxic materials like mercury, etc., are NOT allowed to be sold at the show. Minerals and substances of dubious nature must be kept out of children's reach and must not be sold to children either.

Any information related to the sale of minerals regarding so-called "Healing," i.e., the healing power of stones, is **NOT allowed**.

Exhibitors are responsible for any damage they cause.

Booking rules:

- **Applications must be received by SGS no later than June 1, 2026.**
- **Applications must be made in writing via online registration, email, or letter.**
- **SGS sends a confirmation with instructions for payment via e-mail or letter.**

Cancellation rules

Full cancellation rights apply up to 10 days before the fair. Thereafter, a medical certificate is required for a refund. The entire paid amount will be refunded if the cancellation rules are followed.

Transfer of tables

Exhibitors are NOT allowed to rent or transfer tables to others.

Tables not occupied by 10:00 AM on Saturday, or vacated tables will be rented out by SGS and allocated according to the waiting list.

Service

Toilets are available in the form of "Bajamajor" near the exhibition area.

At the Kitchen and Garden Café, you can enjoy both meals and coffee. In the large Greenhouse (indoor exhibition), there is also a café area with coffee available for purchase.

Party with Meal

During Saturday evening, SGS will organize a party with a meal and mingling for the exhibitors. Food and drinks will be provided by Hellekis Kitchen and Garden Café.

Note: Pre-registration is required for this event, which is binding, and payment in advance must be made when paying for the table rental.

For special dietary requests, this must be clearly indicated at the time of registration.

Accommodation

The lower part of the large parking lot (next to the show area) is reserved for the parking of caravans and motorhomes.

Note: Pre-registration for a parking space including electricity should be made when booking a table. The fee is paid in advance at the same time as the table rental payment.

Directions

From E 20: Turn onto road 44 at Götene, take right towards Hällekis, pass Forshem and continue towards Hällekis. Pass through the village and then follow signs towards Stenmässå/Hellekis Säteri.

From Lidköping, road 44: At Källby, turn off towards "Hällekis/Kinneulle". Follow the road towards Hällekis. After 15 km, at the end of the long downhill . Follow signs towards Stenmässå/Hellekis Säteri.
